Scott Qualey, building inspector, was present at the board meeting per the board's request. Scott's presence was requested to answer questions from the supervisors and meet the new board.

After a very brief discussion a motion was made by Bob Leifeld to compensate planning commission members at their meeting pay rate when they attend board meetings at the request of the supervisors. Seconded by Bernie Pistner, all in favor. Motion carried.

The board heard a request from Mulvihill Excavating to gain approval to use the townships weight restricted roads to remove equipment from his shop to another storage location.

Motion by Bob Leifeld and seconded by Bernie Pistner to approve Mulvihill's request. All in

**favor motion passed.** Mr. Mulvihill was provided a letter from the board giving written approval.

It was reported by Melissa Timm, clerk, that March's election saw 23 voters. The final tally for the election was 22 votes for Jim Sipe and 1 write-in. Jim's term will begin in April 2014 and expire in March 2017.
