WHEREAS, Be it resolved that this Hampton Township Board of Supervisors shall adopt this resolution to allow the change below regarding permits that have in the past had to attend a planning commission meeting for pre-approval.

For the purpose of enforcing the permit application process, a building permit shall be required of all persons intending to construct, alter, enlarge, repair, move, demolish, or change the use of a building or structure

- 1. If there are no changes to the exterior footprint or height of the structure and the use classification is not changing, the Town Clerk shall forward the application to the Building Official for review without Planning Commission or Board oversight.
- 2. If there are changes to the building footprint, but the new proposed exterior building walls are more than three times the required setback from property lines and no change to the use classification is proposed, the Town Clerk is authorized to forward the application to the Building Official for review without Planning Commission or Board oversight.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of Township of Hampton will allow the clerk to submit the building application to the Building Official for approval and building permit if it meets the above criteria.
