RESOLUTION APPROVING SUMMARY PUBLICATION OF
ORDINANCE NO. 2015-12 BY TITLE AND SUMMARY

WHEREAS, on Dec 15, 2015 the Town Board of Hampton Township adopted the an amendment to the Hampton Township Zoning Ordinance regarding, lots of record, zoning applications, unpaid fees, solar energy systems, driveway accesses, feedlots, the readoption of certain past amendments, and other minor provisions. (the "Ordinance");

WHEREAS, Minnesota statute, sections 365.125, subdivision 2 and 368.01, subdivision 21 allow the publication of a summary of an ordinance instead of publishing the whole ordinance;

WHEREAS, the Town Board determines it is impractical to publish the entire Ordinance and that publication of an approved summary of the Ordinance is sufficient to inform the public of its content and where to obtain a full copy of the Ordinance;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Board hereby determines to publish the following summary language, which is hereby approved, in lieu of publishing the full text of the Ordinance:

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE HAMPTON TOWNSHIP ZONING ORDINANCE

The Town Board of Hampton Township adopted Ordinance No. 2015-12 to amend its zoning ordinance regarding, but not limited to, provisions relating to lots of record, zoning applications, unpaid fees, solar energy systems, driveway accesses, feedlots, and the readoption of certain past amendments. A copy of the full ordinance is available at the Town Hall, the Hastings Public Library, and can be obtained by contacting the Town Clerk.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Town Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to:

- Publish the above approved summary once in the Town's official newspaper;
- Post a copy of the full ordinance on the Town Hall bulletin board;
- Place a copy of the full ordinance at the Hastings Public Library;

- Place a copy of the full ordinance at the Dakota County Law Library;
- Record a copy of the Ordinance with the County Recorder's office
- Provide the Dakota County Zoning Administrator a copy of the full ordinance; and
- Place the ordinance in the Town Ordinance Book within 20 days together with a copy of the affidavit of having published the approved summary language.


