

Planning Commission Meeting Minutes August 13, 2018 7:30pm

Meeting was called to order by Jeremy Irrthum at 7:30pm.

Darrel Oistad (Beta Seed) - 612-240-8185

- Requesting an AG permit to build a 64x104 foot AG shed with 16 foot side walls
- 6601 280th Street

Darrel requested an AG permit for a 64x 104 foot AG shed on 150 acres. It will be North of their existing building that is about 50 x 100 feet. It will be 20 feet from Kyle Shay's property line. There were no residents present and no discussion on this by the Planning Commission. Dave Peine made a motion to recommend to the Town Board that they approve the 64 x 104 foot AG permit for Beta Seed located at 6601 280th Street. Larry Runyan seconded it. Motion carried.

Gene & Judy Kimmes - 651-480-2293

- Dan's Bar wants to buy some land for a septic drain field
- Kevin & Katie Weatherly are wondering about a buildable on the Endres Farm PID#17-01400-50-011
- It is 154.95 acres and should have 3 buildables

Gene & Judy were in for information only. They mentioned they were approached by Dan's Bar for a septic drain field. It would be part of a 76 acre parcel they have. Kimmes's will need to come back once they know what Dan's Bar is requesting. Gene & Judy were also requesting some information about a buildable on the Endres Farm that Katie and Kevin Weatherly were interested in buying. Kevin was told his shed could have a maximum height of 35 feet and he can build a shed that is 4.5% of total square footage. For example: he could build about a 40x70 foot shed for 1.5 acres of land, about 2940 feet of building not including the house or garage. He could do about 3920 feet for 2 acres and about 5880 feet for 3 acres. Driveway location and frontage was discussed. It was recommended that Gene & Judy Kimmes establish their buildables before they sell the land to the Weatherly's, otherwise there is a possibility they could lose a buildable. They might need to cluster houses first since a cluster needs a full 80, 120 or 180.

Since this was informational only no recommendations were made by the Planning Commission for either question.
