**RESOLUTION APPROVING SUMMARY LANGUAGE FOR
PUBLICATION OF AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE HAMPTON
TOWNSHIP ZONING ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT DATA CENTERS**

WHEREAS, on SEPTEMBER 15, 2026, the Town Board of Hampton Township adopted Ordinance No. 2026-02, “An Ordinance Amending the Hampton Township Zoning Ordinance to Prohibit Data Centers” (“Ordinance”);

WHEREAS, the Town Board determines it is not practical to publish the entire text of the Ordinance in the Town’s official newspaper;

WHEREAS, Minnesota Statute, section 365.125, subdivision 3 allows the publication of a summary of an ordinance instead of publishing the entire ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board determines publication of a summary of the Ordinance is sufficient to clearly inform the public of the intent and effect of the Ordinance and where to access the full text of the Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Board hereby determines to publish the following summary language, which is hereby approved, in lieu of publishing the full text of the Ordinance:

**ORDINANCE AMENDING THE HAMPTON TOWNSHIP
ZONING ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT DATA CENTERS**

On SEPTEMBER 15, 2026, the Hampton Town Board adopted the above-reference ordinance to prohibit data centers as a land use within all zoning districts in the Town. The ordinance defines a data centers, but excludes data centers below a total of 10,000 square feet and information technology equipment and facilities that are accessory to an allowed principal use. The ordinance is effective immediately. A copy of the full ordinance is posted on the township’s website and can be obtained by contacting the Town Clerk.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Town Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to:

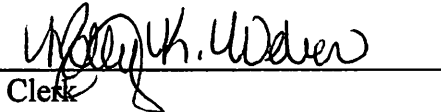
- (1) Publish the approved summary language set out above once in the Town's official newspaper;
- (2) Maintain a copy of the full Ordinance in the office of the Town Clerk to make available for review by the public upon reasonable request;
- (3) Post a copy of the full Ordinance on the Town's website;
- (4) Record a copy of the full Ordinance in the office of the County Recorder;
- (5) Place a copy of the full Ordinance at the Dakota County Public Library in Farmington;
- (6) Place a copy of the full Ordinance at the Dakota County Law Library; and
- (7) Place the Ordinance in the Town Ordinance Book within 20 days together with a copy of the affidavit of having published the approved summary language and a copy of this Resolution.
